What can you do to help?

Don't be a Target

Lock doors, sliding glass door, and windows (even when you are home), lock your vehicle, and don't leave valuables in plain sight. Make it harder and less tempting for the wrong person to get access to you and/or your home. If you need additional window locks, please contact the office.

Shed Some Light

Remove hiding places by using your front and back porch lights during the evening hours. Report any lighting outages in common areas so that we can make repairs right away.

Report Suspicious Activity

Report all incidents right away to Gateway office staff or Securitas Courtesy Patrol) - OR If you see something that looks like a crime happening, please contact Springfield Police 541-726-3714. *If it is an emergency, contact 911*.
